



How to create a video presentation with "Loom"

Loom is a web tool designed for self-recording of video presentations and tutorials (screencasts). A screencast films your activity on your computer screen. You can record an audio presentation while showing your presentation on your screen as well as a shot of your face while you are speaking. After you are finished with your presentation you can save and edit the file. This way you do not have to begin from the start if you made a mistake during the record.

How does "Loom" work?

After you registered online and installed the app on your computer a small window will open. You can choose if you want to record your screen, your camera or both at once. You can choose "show advanced options" to select your record mode.

When you are finished with your record, it will be saved in your library at <u>www.loom.com</u>. Here you can edit your video presentation, f.e. cut out unnecessary fill words like "ahem".

Recording Quality and Costs

To generate the necessary quality recording we recommend the Loom- **Business**-Package for advanced recording & analytics. Its about \$8 the month and can be canceled after one month.
